Urban development plan

At a special municipal council meeting, on August 15, a new project modifying the urban development plan was adopted. It is the 5th version. These changes were made to respect the MRC rules.

These modifications are or will be on the municipality's web site.

Here is the calendar for the adoption of the plan

- Monday August 15: adoption by resolution of the project for the urban development at a special meeting
 - <u>Sunday August 28</u>: Publication of a summary in the Petite-Nation newspaper and notice of a public consultation
- <u>Saturday September 17</u>: Public consultation meeting starting at 9 am
- <u>Saturday September 17</u> Adoption of the urban development plan by the council at a special meeting at 2 pm
- <u>Saturday october 15</u>: Registry: Those opposed to the plan will be able to register their opposition by signing the registry. 160 signatures are needed to oppose the plan. This is subject to confirmation

INVITED: All paid-up members of the APLG for 2005 are cordially invited. If you have not yet paid your membership, we will collect your 10\$ and you're on!


COST: \$12 per person. Children 10 and under, free. You must confirm before August 30. (Payment on the site)
